

Terms and Conditions for Trade Sites (Trade Stall Holders)

Golden Bay A&P Show 17 January 2026

- Trade site applicant signatories must be at least 18 years of age and always supervise minors on their stand.
- Trade Stall Holders are responsible for the safety of their site and for complying with all requirements under the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
- Trade Stall Holders must comply with Golden Bay A&P Association policies, rules and orders, and other legislative requirements relevant to the operation of and within the show.
- The Golden Bay A&P Association Committee accepts no liability for any accident, injury or loss that might occur on the show grounds.
- Food health and safety certificate must be current and displayed.
- Powered sites require an electrical WOF for a mobile unit and RCD fittings for any connection to our supplied power source. Bring your own heavy duty power cord which must be tested and tagged.
- Food stall holders are reminded that sales of hot dogs and/or chips and candyfloss are not permitted as this contravenes our agreement with Sturgeons Amusements.
- Maximum vehicle speed of 10kmph on site. No trade vehicle movement between 9am and 4pm
- Trade Stall Holders may set up sites on the Friday before the show, and note that we do not supply any security personnel
- All trade sites are to be fully set up by 9am (with vehicles parked up) the morning of the show and not to be dismantled before 4.00pm.
- Every Trade Stall Holder must only set up on the site to which they have been allocated (numbered)
- Keep within your allocated site. Do not encroach on neighbouring areas trade sites or other demarcated areas such as the walkway between trade sites and the central showground barrier.
- Complimentary beverages must be consumed on your trade site.
- Dogs are not permitted on the grounds – (Tasman District Council bylaw).
